The VA LIONS Football Program represents a tremendous opportunity for our communities' homeschooled, privately schooled and publicly schooled high school boys and girls to participate in a sports program that teaches the fundamentals of football and cheerleading, teamwork and sportsmanship.

VA LIONS is a non-profit organization¹ run entirely by volunteers. Parents, members and many in the community have already given tirelessly of their time and resources, supporting us in many ways - from providing equipment and practice uniforms to participating in team fundraisers - all of which has helped our organization enormously.

The cost of purchasing safety, game and field equipment, and insurance is significant. The cost of registration only covers a small portion of the year's expenses. Each child is outfitted entirely by the organization (uniform, pads, helmet, etc.) which helps defray the costs for many families who would not otherwise have their high school aged boys in a football program. We are diligently trying to reduce the cost of registration to an amount financially feasible for as many families as possible, and we are working toward offering financial assistance in the form of reduced, or even waived registration fees, when appropriate. Although we are based in the Loudoun area, we accept players from all over. It would be ideal for the organization to eventually expand into other counties, further assisting parents with regard to travel and convenience.

Our organization is focused on much more than recreation. We are driven to motivate and mentor those who participate. We are determined to prepare and position the players for the collegiate level, constantly in search of opportunities to provide the exposure our players need. Our focus is to get the players scholarships and acceptance into the colleges they desire, while maintaining that they are committed to being upstanding and honorable men and women.
