PLAYERS

2009 Registration Fee \$250 * (*Payment plans are available*)

FAMILY DISCOUNT

The first child registered for contact football is \$250. Any additional children registering after that will receive a discount. The reduced rate shall be \$200.00.

CHEERLEADERS

2009 Registration Fee \$150 * (*Payment plans are available*)

FAMILY DISCOUNT

The first child registered for cheerleading is \$150. Any additional children registering after that will receive a discount. The reduced rate shall be \$120.

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION * 08/01/09: STILL ACCEPTING REGISTRATIONS

Full payment of the 2009 registration fee is due no later than July 31, 2009. Fees paid at any 2009 LIONS' camp are part of the 2009 registration fee and are deducted from the balance due by July 31, 2009.

Your registration fee includes your rental of equipment and uniforms, and the costs for field fees, referee fees, and other miscellaneous expenses (such as first aid supplies, team insurance, etc.).

All registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. The coaching staff determines placement on a team.

SPORTS PHYSICALS

Contact football players must submit a physician's statement dated within twelve (12) months of August 2009, certifying that they are physically able to play football. No player will be allowed to participate in any contact practice session until this statement is received. ***For your convenience, blank sports physical forms are available for printing from our website.***

REGISTRATION FORMS

All registration forms must be signed to acknowledge understanding of, and agreement to, the Athletic Participation Waiver and the Code of Conduct. ***For your convenience, this form is attached, and available for printing from our website.***

WEIGH-IN AND TEAM PLACEMENT

Weigh-In dates are offered once or twice between annual Spring Camps and Summer Camps. All contact football players are encouraged to attend to complete their registration process. Players are weighed in and *may* be evaluated by the coaches for placement purposes at these sessions. Twelve and thirteen year olds who wish to be considered must attend a minimum of one camp **and** weigh-in session to be evaluated. No pads are required. Shirt, shorts, and tennis shoes or cleats are required for weigh-ins. No sandals.

My child has had a physical examination within the last year and has been found physically capable of participation in the Programs.

Therefore, I grant Le'Shon Owens, Executive Director, and/or any Coach or team parent as necessary, permission to act as my surrogate for my child in the area of obtaining medical treatment by a doctor of medicine or dentistry. I also assume full financial responsibility for any medical treatment administered to my child as a result of his participation in the Programs.

1. Conduct themselves in a mature and respectable manner.
2. Speak kindly and respectfully.

5. Be present at all practices and games except in cases of illness or with a Coach's pre-approval.

Code of Conduct (Continued):

Parents, Spectators, Attendees, Coaches, Coordinators and Participants:

Shall conduct themselves in a prudent manner at all games, practices, and camps. The use, consumption, or presence of any tobacco, drugs, intoxicants or alcoholic beverage is prohibited. Riotous, boisterous, threatening or indecent conduct, or the use of abusive, threatening, or indecent language shall not be tolerated. Unauthorized presence on the playing or practice fields shall not be allowed at any time. The Program maintains the right to aggressively pursue charges against anyone who engages in any misconduct or criminal behavior at our facilities.

The following shall not be tolerated:

1. Use of foul language.
2. Abusing participants (opposition or fans by word or gesture).
3. Harassing the officials.
4. Disobeying or attempting to circumvent rules and regulations, or the intent thereof.
5. At anytime, lay a hand upon, strike, or threaten to strike an official, spectator, Coach or another participant.
6. Refusal to abide by an official's decision, or be guilty of objectionable demonstrations of dissent at an official's decision, in any forceful action.
7. Falsify participant's age.

Any Coach, coordinator, participant, spectator, attendee, or parent not abiding by this Code of Conduct will be notified in writing of any misconduct. Disciplinary action will be at the Board's discretion.
